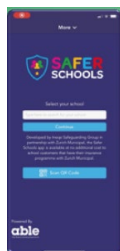

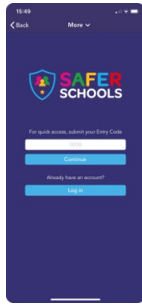
Safer Schools provides a range of award winning services. The app can be personalized for each member of the school community with topics that include image sharing, social media, online bullying, safer gaming and more.

Filtered Internet Services

Our Trust has filtering and monitoring services provided by TWS, this makes use of Netsweeper: Internet filtering systems meeting 360 Degree E-Safety Standard Level 3 in place to prevent access to illegal and inappropriate material whilst allowing your school to make the most of cloud hosted technologies such as Google G-Suite, Microsoft Office 365.

The service offers:

Website filtering designed for education, including safe access to search engines with safe search enforced and YouTube restricted mode where required.

A large array of web filter reporting tools available including ability to report to staff on a daily basis to support your CARE and Prevent strategies.

The above package also notifies the safeguarding team of concerns that can be followed up in the appropriate way.
