What we want to change or develop?	<ul> <li>Uniform: thoughts on current uniform: positive, negative</li> <li>The t shirt and jumper are itchy</li> <li>Wearing black is very hot in the summer – need a lighter option</li> <li>It does help wearing joggers for children who have sensory issues</li> <li>We know that we have to have a new uniform because we are going to a new trust, and will be North Star.</li> <li>What would we like to see: Formal/smart: how?</li> <li>Blazers?</li> <li>It will take people time to get used to the change and some people would not 'suit' blazers/would not like them (discussed how they had already gone through a change and coped well)</li> <li>You would feel more confident for school</li> <li>Siblings in other schools wear blazers and they got used to them, are not worried about them</li> </ul>	

<ul> <li>We would have more control over keeping warm and cool, we can undo or do them up without taking it off</li> <li>Asked if they could take them off when it is hot weather? Will be able to in the summer if we get really hot. Mrs McDicken is very understanding.</li> <li>Shirts?</li> <li>White cotton shirts are better because they are cooler</li> <li>They reflect the light and heat</li> <li>Not itchy</li> <li>Can wear long or short sleeve so everyone can choose what is best for them.</li> <li>Worried about the collar. Said they would choose shirts with looser collar and still able to attach tie.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Ties?</li> <li>We are worried about normal ties. People could get hurt, strangle each other. Would be clip on.</li> <li>People could take each other's ties.</li> <li>Siblings wear them and got used to them.</li> <li>Would look the same.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Shoes?</li> <li>Black shoes are ok</li> <li>Look smarter than trainers</li> <li>Would like to wear trainers sometimes. Talked about saving their best trainers for outside school, social time</li> <li>Can they have logos? Even if black? Should be plain and polishable. However, can be smart trainer-shoe. Mrs McDicken will confirm.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Reasons behind smart uniform?</li> <li>Uniforms are better when we go on a school trip so we can be recognised</li> <li>All look the same, look united</li> <li>No bullying</li> <li>Look smart</li> <li>Helps us get ready for uniforms when we go to work or college later</li> <li>Worried about the cost for parents/carers. Said that the main parts would be provided, just like this year. That as people grow out of uniform,</li> </ul>

	they can swap it out/others can use. Shirts and trousers would be plain so parents/carers can get them from supermarkets.
